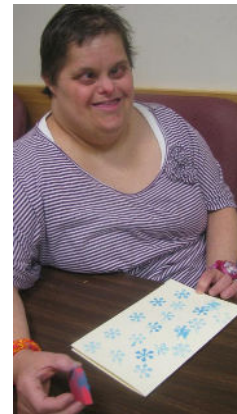
We Believe in Giving Back

CARF Accreditation



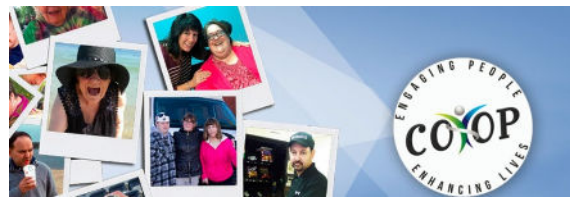
